Success Criteria

Talk Skill	Example	Tick each time you observe the behaviour
Instigate: To begin the discussion, involve others and move the conversation in a different direction	 'I think the first thing we should consider is' 'Ok, to begin with, let's talk about' 'Jenny, what's your view on this' 'How about we circle back to the idea of as we didn't explore it in much detail' 'Shall we move on to consider' 	
Clarify: To make things clearer and to simplify things	 'What do you mean when you say?' 'Could you tell me more about?' 'Does that mean that?' 	
Build To develop, add to or run with an idea, and make connections between ideas	 'I agree and I'd like to add' 'Building on that idea' 'That idea is picked up elsewhere in the novel' 'That's quite similar / different to' 	
Probe To dig deeper into the argument, asking for evidence or justification of ideas	 'What evidence do you have to support that?' 'How did you come to that conclusion?' 	
Challenge To disagree with, or to present an alternative argument	 'Yes, but' 'You mentioned X but what about' 'I disagree. Have you considered' 	
Summarise To present reflections on the discussion, or to offer a conclusion or balanced assessment of the main points.	 'Overall, the main points we've covered so far are' 'From today's discussion, it's clear that'
