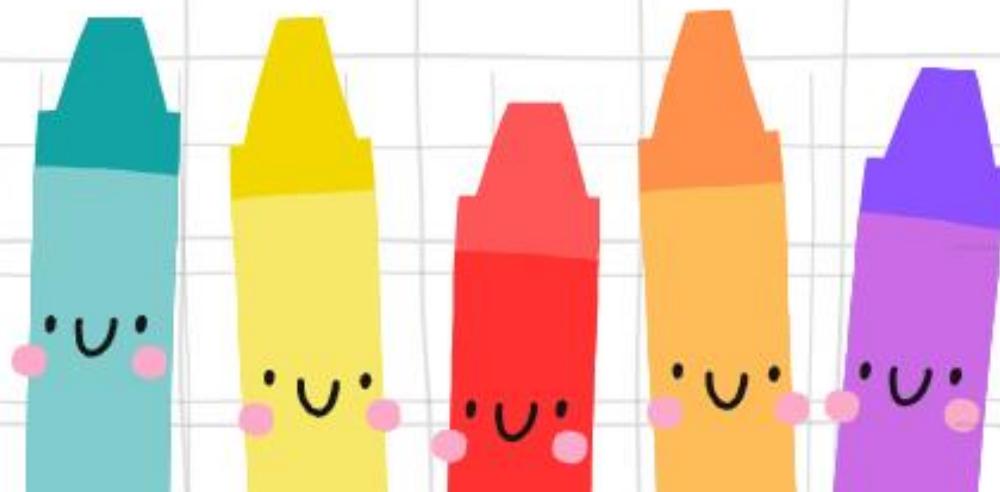



	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Children have pictures of appropriate subjects and verbs to choose from in order to verbally say their own sentence.</li> <li>Appropriately give a capital letter, use phonics sounds and add the full stop to demarcate the sentence.</li> <li>Initially text can be used under the pictures of trickier words but moving towards removing this as confidence grows.</li> </ul>		 <p>Subject, verb Adjective, subject, verb</p> <p>Duck walked.
